SYSTEMIC DEFICIENCIES:

- 1. Indicating the throw in spot when you are the administrating official
- 2. Closing down on all shots in the trail and center position
- 3. Working the arc properly (Most stop at nearest lane line)
- 4. Widening out as the lead to observe rebounding action (Stuck in the B position)
- 5. Rushing the foul reporting sequence (It got better as the progressed)
- 6. Closing down on the final free throw as the trail on a 3 person crew

Improvements:

- 1. Wrapping back
- 2. Closing on the free throw as the trail (2-person crew) & center

- 3. Indicating the throw in spot when not the administrating official
- 4. At the site of the foul reporting being proper and acknowledged by partners
